*Other documents may be required. All required documentation must be received in order to process an application. If it is not received in 30 days of initial consultation, your case will be closed. The withholding or falsifying of information is grounds for termination within this program.

What is the Empowering Military & Veteran Families Initiative?

Couple & Family Retreats

With a busy family life, parents may not have the time to focus on one another in order to maintain their relationship of a constructive two-parent home. Couples retreats offer a weekend away to develop or rekindle strong bonds through communication, one-on-one focused interactions while expanding relationship skills and building upon a stronger foundation. As the marriage stays strong, the family as a whole can maintain its strength.

We have partnered with the Family Support Center through the Roudebush VA to sponsor couples retreats for those who are enrolled into the VA health care system. These events are hosted in different locations throughout the state. Other retreats are available for those who do not qualify. Additionally, we have partnered with Bradford Woods in Martinsville, IN to host retreats for military service members who have actively served and their families. These Family Battle Buddies Retreats offers time with other military families in a fun, outdoor environment while learning family continuity, strength development and coping skills.

Counseling and Alternative Therapy*

Licensed therapists are available to either meet with you individually, as a couple or the entire family to resolve common life issues. We highly encourage positive interactions with all members of the family in forming stronger relations and understanding.

We also offer alternative therapies and parental workshops. These parenting opportunities work to encourage children and parents with skills needed for a positive, structured family environment. The alternative means of therapy are through equine and art sessions. Horse therapy is structured to assist those who have experienced trauma or have disabilities. The art therapy in Castleton is offered to male and female veterans as well as family sessions.



Childcare & Tutoring

We know that it can be difficult to balance all of the demands of employment or education while ensuring your children are receiving care in a safe learning environment. This program is statewide and can assist you with paying for state-licensed childcare if you meet the low-income requirement.

Additionally, if your child is struggling in school, we offer in-home tutoring so that your child can succeed. The tutors available can also assist children who have special needs.
